Dress code

Bristol Museum & Art Gallery does not have a formal dress code for guests arriving for events but we request that sportswear is avoided.

Token System – how does it work?

Drinks tokens are distributed to guests upon arrival and exchanged at the bar for either a glass of house wine, a bottled beer/ cider, single spirit and mixer or two soft drinks.

Contracted Numbers

Please make sure you are aware of your contracted minimum numbers, these cannot be altered after the contract is signed. Your package price will not differ if your guests do not attend the event. Final catering numbers are required 2 weeks before the event date

Drop-off Areas

We do allow coaches/ taxi's and buses to offer a short drop off directly outside the front of the museum.

Car Parking

There are two multi story car parks nearby, West End (BS8 1EH) and Trenchard Street (BS1 5AN) Elmdale Rd, Bristol BS8 1SL has free parking after 7pm.

Smoking

Smoking is not permitted on Bristol Museum & Art Gallery premises. Please exit the building to smoke (includes vaping).

Security

We operate a Challenge 25 policy for bar service. Please be prepared to show ID if requested. We retain the right to search all personal belongings brought onto the property and confiscate any prohibited items.


